EXTENSIVE PORTFOLIO

Benjamin Mäße, Sales Coordinator at Night Star Express, who initiated the contact with Delphi, and Sarra Horchani, Business Development Manager CEP Services and Delphi contact for shareholder Hellmann, visited Rüdiger Hölzel at Delphi Technologies' German head office in Düsseldorf. As Country Director DACH, Rüdiger Hölzel is respon-

sible for after-sales. He is proud of Delphi's product portfolio: "We offer service and repair solutions for almost any vehicle in any country. On top of this, we provide special tools/machines and repair concepts for complex components, such as injection systems. Special training and qualification programmes complete the offering. Remanufacturing is another means of enhancing sustainability: Previously sold parts are rebuilt to extend their useful life. Delphi also sells the machinery needed for remanufacturing. The first shipments were collected from the Delphi Technologies warehouse in Wrocław, Poland, and shipped via the Night Star Express system in October. Ahead of this, Sarra Horchani and Benjamin Mäße liaised closely with their contacts from procurement, sales and customer service. "Everything was carefully coordinated and the first shipments were delivered smoothly. We are optimally prepared for the growing number of shipments," they add with confidence.

REVIEW OF THE INTERNATIONAL SUPPLY CHAIN CONFERENCE 2021

A RETURN TO IN-PERSON NETWORKING AT LAST

After 18 months without in-person events, we at Night Star Express weren't the only ones who were delighted to meet face to face again at the supply chain conference. Resembling a who's who of the industry, the event took place in Berlin from 20 to 22 October 2021. Most of the talks and panel discussions could also be followed live online. Due to coronavirus, last year's International Supply Chain Conference was a purely digital affair. To enable in-person networking this year in a Covid-secure fashion, the organiser BVL (Bundesvereinigung Logistik) developed a safety and hygiene concept based on the official guidance. Visitors had to provide evidence before the event that they had been vaccinated or had recently recovered from the virus or bring a recent negative coronavirus test with them.

The function room at Hotel Intercontinental. where the conference is held each year, was also equipped with a ventilation system and the exhibitors' stands were set up at a distance from one another. The State of Ber-

RAISING MONEY FOR THE UNNA REGION TOO THERAPY EQUIPMENT FOR THE "LEBENSZENTRUM KÖNIGSBORN"

The "Lebenszentrum Königsborn" is a recognised centre of expertise for people with disabilities in Unna-Königsborn. Staff at the centre support and treat people with multiple severe disabilities, adults in a vegetative state or recovering from neurological trauma, and children and young people with neurological conditions or social and psychological problems.

Night Star Express is donating funds for a Galileo training and therapy device which is based on the natural sequence of movements that we make when we walk. The rapid see-sawing motion of the training platform simulates the way our body tilts when we walk, but is more intense. The human body reacts reflexively to the platform's movements, activating and strengthening groups of muscles involuntarily. This type of training promotes muscle activity along with the patient's circulation and metabolism.

NEW PALLET DELIVERY SERVICE HAS BEEN LAUNCHED!

NEW OPTION FOR SWISS CUSTOMERS

The service portfolio offered by Night Star Express Schweiz AG continues to grow! Since October, clients have also been able to ship pallets nationwide via the overnight express service. This new service was added to the Night Star Express Schweiz AG portfolio after intensive preparations.

Within the company, there have been discussions for several years about expanding the product range to include overnight delivery of palletised shipments weighing up to 150 kg. This additional service was finally rolled out in early October.

Marcel Tüscher, Managing Director of Night Star Express Schweiz AG, explains the process: "Within the company, we first floated the idea of transporting palletised shipments and ways in which we could do that back in 2012. However, incorporating this service into our portfolio posed too high a risk with regard to the capacity utilisation of our trucks and buses."

INCREASE IN SHIPMENTS DESPITE COVID

The topic was raised again in 2021, the second year of the pandemic. Marcel Tüscher describes the operational deliberations that preceded the decision: "Due to the rising number of shipments, we decided to relieve pressure on our drivers and expand our service at the same time. In October, we launched a '2nd night shift', meaning that a second fleet of lorries with a through-loading ing up to 150 kg to recipients on time. our range of overnight transport services," system sets out at a different time. These lorries can carry up to 16 Euro-pallets and have a payload of 2,600 kg. They are not subject to the night driving ban which applies from 10 p.m. in Switzerland."
